

**SWATCH-FIVB WORLD TOUR Start Notes – 2005 INFOTE Athens Open, September 1**

- This is the third of six days of competition for the US\$400,000 **INFOTE Athens Open**.
- Athens hosts the first world athletic event to take place in Greece after the Olympic Games. The SWATCH-FIVB Beach Volleyball World Tour **INFOTE Athens Open** is being co-organized by the City of Athens Organization for Youth and Sport and the Hellenic Volleyball Federation at the Beach Volleyball Olympic Venue in the Faliron Coastal Zone.
- This is the 12th event on the 2005 SWATCH-FIVB World Tour for both women and men.
- The 2005 **INFOTE Athens Open** is the sixth men's and seventh international Beach Volleyball events held in Greece. Prior to the Athens 2004 Olympic Games, the Olympic Beach Volleyball Center at the Faliron Coastal Zone hosted a 2003 FIVB Challenger stop. Greece also hosted double gender challenger events in 2000 and 2001 with Rhodes the site of "open" events for both men (2004) and women (2002-2004).
- A total of 32 countries have entered men's and women's teams into the **INFOTE Athens Open**, including **Argentina, Australia, Austria, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Cuba, Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Moldova, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Russia, Serbia and Montenegro, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the Ukraine and Venezuela.**

**Women's 2005 INFOTE Athens Open**

- The **INFOTE Athens Open** is the 130th women's SWATCH-FIVB World Tour Beach Volleyball event (open, grand slam, Olympic and Goodwill). The first women's SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event was played August 14-16, 1992 at Almeria, Spain.
- A total of 21 countries have entered women's teams into the **INFOTE Athens Open**, including **Australia, Austria, Brazil, Bulgaria, China, Cuba, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Greece, Italy, Japan, Latvia, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the Ukraine and Venezuela.**
- There will be a "touch of the Olympics" when the women's SWATCH-FIVB World Tour returns to Athens after the success of the 2004 Summer Games. The event will be the fifth "open" FIVB for Greece as Rhodes hosted the women's international tour the past three seasons where Olympic champions Misty May and Kerri Walsh won 2004 titles. Ana Paula Connelly and Sandra Pires won the 2003 Rhodes gold medal with Holly McPeak and Elaine Youngs the 2002 winners. Xylokastro hosted FIVB challenger events twice where Lina Yanchulova/Petia Yanchulova of Bulgaria (2000) and Rong Chi/Zi Xiong (2001) of China won titles. Vasso Karadassiou and Efi Sfyri, who placed second in the 2000 Xylokastro challenger, was third in the 2002 Rhodes event for Greece's best finish as a host country.

- The **INFOTE Athens Open** is the 174th men's SWATCH-FIVB World Tour Beach Volleyball event (open, grand slam, Olympic and Goodwill) for men. The first SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event was played February 17-22, 1987 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
- A total of 28 countries have entered men's teams into the **INFOTE Athens Open**, including **Argentina, Australia, Austria, Brazil, Canada, Cuba, Czech Republic, Estonia, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Moldova, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Russia, Serbia and Montenegro, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the Ukraine.**
- **Men** – With the "afterglow" of the 2004 Olympic Games, Athens hosts a men's SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event. Dain Blanton and Jeff Nygaard won a 2003 "open" event in Rhodes while Fabio Galli and Riccardo Fenili of Italy won a FIVB challenger event in 2003.

**SWATCH-FIVB U-19 World Championships** – Teams from Brazil and Slovenia captured the 2005 SWATCH-FIVB U-19 World Championships in Saint Quay Portrieux, France Sunday (August 19). The "third-time was the charm" for Brazil's Barbra **Figueiredo** as she captured the women's SWATCH-FIVB U-19 World Championships with Carolina Aragao by defeating defending champions Katarzyna Urban and Joanna Wiatr of Poland for the title. After placing second the past two years with Carolina Solberg Salgado, Figueiredo gained the top spot on the U-19 podium with Aragao as the young Brazilians scored a 21-14, 15-21 and 15-10 win in 52 minutes over Urban and Wiatr.
