### September 3 Women's Medal Match Notes – INFOTE Athens Open

**JULIANA/LARISSA CLINCH** – It appears that Juliana and Larissa have clinched the 2005 SWATCH-FIVB World Tour women's points title with four events left on the schedule. If second-place Tian Jia and Wang Fei had entered the next women's event in Bali (September 14-18), the Chinese had a mathematical chance to catch the young Brazilians. Juliana and Larissa have 5,284 points with a potential of 40 more points if they win the gold medal at the INFOTE Athens Open. The Chinese have 3,744 points to trail the Brazilians by 1,540 points. If Tian Jia and Wang Fei had entered Bali, they had to win the remaining four events this season and hoped that Juliana and Larissa did not play in anymore events after Athens. The Brazilians are entered in the Bali event with other SWATCH stops scheduled for Brazil, Mexico and South Africa.

**JULIANA/LARISSA SET** – With their semi-final win Friday evening, Juliana and Larissa set a record for the most money earned in a calendar year by a men's or women's team (\$333,750 in 12 events) to break the previous best of \$332,000 set by Emanuel Rego and ZeMarco de Melo of Brazil in 1996 (14 events). Juliana and Larissa set the women's mark last week in Montreal with their gold medal finish.

**Shelda** (age, 32) and **Adriana** (36) are playing in their 96th SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event with 88 "final four" finishes with a FIVB record 31 gold medals, 26 silvers and 20 bronzes. Since 2002 on the SWATCH-FIVB World Tour, Adriana and Shelda have a 210-46 match mark together, including 38-14 this season. Adriana and Shelda captured the silver medal in both the 2000 and 2004 Olympic Games. Adriana and Shelda posted podium finishes at four of the last five FIVB World Championships, including gold medals in 1999 and 2001, silver medal in 2003 and bronze medal in 1997. The Brazilians were fifth at the 2005 worlds in June at Berlin. Adriana and Shelda have won six of the last eight SWATCH-FIVB World Tour season point's title. The pair had won five-straight season point's titles (1997-2001) and ranks No. 1 in career FIVB earnings together (\$1,924,115). The pair also won the 1999 Pan American Games in Winnipeg, Canada. Adriana and Shelda have a 19-7 mark on the Brazilian tour this season with three seconds, a fourth and two fifths together in six events.

**Karadassiou** (age, 32) and **Arvaniti** (20) are competing in their 10th SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event. This is their third "final four" appearance for the team with a silver medal finish in June at Milan, Italy, and a gold medal placement in July in Stavanger, Norway. Those were the first two medals for a Greek women's or men's team on the SWATCH-FIVB World Tour. With a guaranteed fourth this week, the Greeks have now earned \$143,000, together this year. Individually, the \$71,500 is the most money earned by either player on the SWATCH-FIVB World Tour. A nine-season veteran, Karadassiou's best earnings for a season was \$27,500 in 2003 with her two-time Olympic partner Efi Sfyri. Arvaniti, who is playing her third full-season internationally, earned \$23,750 in 2003 with her Olympic partner Efthalia Koutroumanidou. Both Greek teams placed ninth in the Athens Olympic. Karadassio and Arvaniti have also won the European Championships last Saturday in Moscow. Prior to that, they won an European confederation stop in Lucerne, Switzerland, and placed second in Valenca, Spain. The pair has a 14-1 European mark this season with \$34,750 in winnings. For the season, the Greeks are 48-18 with \$177,750 in earnings.

**Juliana** (age, 22) and **Larissa** (23) are playing in their 22nd SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event together. The pair has 15 "final four" finishes together, including 2004 gold in Mallorca, and 2005 titles in Shanghai, Milan, Gstaad, St. Petersburg and Montreal. The pair has now reached 11 women's SWATCH-FIVB World Tour semi-finals this season in 12 starts. With \$457,750 in earnings together to rank fifth all-time on the SWATCH list, Juliana and Larissa are the fastest women's team to reach the \$400,000 in history. The pair has a 115-28 FIVB career match mark together, including 65-11 this season. The \$333,750 earnings for Juliana and Larissa this year is a SWATCH-FIVB World Tour single-season record for both men and women breaking the previous mark of \$332,000 by Emanuel Rego and ZeMarco deMelo of Brazil in 1996. Juliana and Larissa, who are coached by Francisco Reis, have won four Brazilian domestic events this season in six starts with a 29-3 match record.

**Renata** (age, 22) and **Talita** (23) are playing in their 11th SWATCH-FIVB World Tour event together. The pair has three "final four" finishes with silver medal finishes this season in St. Petersburg and Montreal. Combined with their 7-3 country quota mark this season, Renata and Talita have a 47-18 SWATCH record this season, including 40-15 in qualification and Main Draw play. Renata is in her third full-season on the international tour with a second-place finish last season in Italy with Shaylyn Bede. She has now earned \$103,950 in her SWATCH career. This is Talita's first full-season on the SWATCH-FIVB World Tour with \$54,375 in earnings. Renata and Talita rank seventh on the Brazilian domestic tour this year with a 13-9 mark and a silver medal finish.
